**ERRATA OF AFRIKAANS HOME LANGUAGE AND AFRIKAANS FIRST
ADDITIONAL LANGUAGE GRADE 12 POETRY ANTHOLOGIES**

Curriculum Instruction FO3/2017 must be read in conjunction with Assessment Instruction 12 of 2015, 46 of 2016, 04 of 2017 and 33 of 2017 (these Assessment Instructions are available of the website <http://ecexams>)

1. The National Literature Catalogue for the Further Education and Training (FET) was approved and sent to provinces through Circular S13 in 2015 and sent to district and school officials in the Province of the Eastern Cape.
2. As stipulated in Circular S13 of 2015 and Circular E39 of 2016 and the Assessment Instructions listed above, the new literature texts, which include the Grade 12 poetry anthologies for Afrikaans Home Language and First Additional Language, must be implemented in 2017.



3. However, errors and omissions were identified in the Grade 12 Afrikaans Home Language poetry anthology, i.e. *Verse in my inboks* (Vivlia) and the Grade 12 Afrikaans First Additional language poetry anthology, i.e. *Verskuns* (MacMillan) by teachers and subject advisors in preparation for the implementation of the prescribed poems in 2017.
4. The omissions were brought to the attention of the publishers who have since distributed the lists of the errata to all the schools that purchased these anthologies.

District officials are kindly requested to bring the contents of this Assessment Instruction and the errata lists in **Appendix 1** (*Verse in my inboks* – Vivlia) and **Appendix 2** (*Verskuns* – MacMillan) to the attention of all Afrikaans subject teachers.
