PURPOSE AND RATIONALE OF SRRP SUMMIT

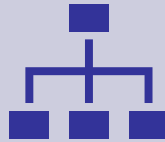
- Improve SRRP conceptualization, through the clarification of roles and responsibilities of all role players internal and external to ECDoE,
- Align Policies that interface with SRRP implementation, e.g., Scholar Transport Policy,
- Emerge with a Programme of Action (PoA) that will culminate in improved stakeholder relations, advocacy for SRRP,
- Improve quality education through adequate resourcing schools, (Retention & Resourcing)



SUMMIT OBJECTIVES



The main objective of the summit is to institutionalize the SRRP program within the ECDoE



Canvass **support to intra- and inter-departmental** stakeholders towards the realization of its strategic objectives, as well as ensuring that all relevant role players are clear of their respective roles and responsibilities



To further solicit inputs and recommendations on how best the implementation of the program can be improved, based on past experiences



SPECIFIC SUMMIT OBJECTIVES

To provide background and context to the duties, functions and responsibilities of all role players, as a broad-stakeholder representative structures within the context of the legislative framework of government,

To collectively devise strategic direction from inputs by the various functional units of the ECDoE and relevant Chief Directorates.

To engage Stakeholders representatives in identifying challenges prohibiting the successful implementation of SRRP and thus collectively formulate possible and practical solutions.

To prepare and produce a Draft Action Plan that could possibly be adopted by **all implementing structures** across the Province for implementation and monitoring of the SRRP.



EXPECTED OUTCOMES

It is envisaged that the **SRRP summit** shall deliver on the following outcomes:

- Strengthened relations between the ECDOE and its stakeholders that will enhance cooperation towards improved service delivery,
- Enable **the Summit** to provide a profound insight to various stakeholders regarding the SRRP and its inherent mission to change the education landscape for achieving desired educational outcomes,
- Improved capacity for various Chief Directorates, State Departments to promote collective participation in education service delivery such that learners & parents regain confidence in public education system,
- To ensure a stable education environment through **effective intra-Departmental and external stakeholder** relations' management in the implementation of CSLP's.
