Stanza two – “frozen” and stanza three – “flake” (from snowflake) (2)</p> <p>1.3. The horse shakes the bells that are tied to his leather strap (that controls him) as if he is indicating that the traveller has made a mistake in the woods. (1)</p> <p>1.4. “lovely, dark, deep” (minus 1 for not using quotation marks) (2)</p> <p>1.5. Strange/odd/unusual (1)</p> <p>1.6. 1. The first meaning is literal: The traveller wants to start his journey because he has a long distance to travel before he reaches his destination and goes to bed/lies down, and rests.
