PROVINCIAL TEACHER DEVELOPMENT COURSES SCHEDULED FOR APRIL 2022 TO MARCH 2023

- 1. In 2022, the Eastern Cape Department of Education (ECDOE) published a Provincial Prospectus including all the Provincial Teacher Development courses scheduled to take place in 2022/23.
- 2. The Teacher Development Chief Directorate is now ready to present the training plan in June/July 2022 to March 2023.
- 3. The courses on offer are to be run during over school holidays, target key curriculum content and teaching methodology in the prioritized subjects as listed on the attached flyers and e-Teaching and Learning training, issued by each of the Teacher Development Institutes.
- 4. All courses are SACE endorsed which means that teachers who attend and complete a course will be awarded CPTD points for their participation.
- 5. Training courses will be decentralized to districts to bring the training as close as possible to the trainees.
- 6. Note that Institutes will host some smaller subjects and required accommodation will be provided, but for those subjects that will be offered in Districts and CMC's, educators need to note that no accommodation will be afforded.

The ECDoE Teacher Development programs featured in this flyer, offer training in subject-specific content and teaching methodologies and comprise 5-day face - to - face workshops during June/July vaccation, which will be mainly decentralized to District level and CMC level, to bring training closer to the teachers, but also prevent the extreme expenditure on accommodation and transport in the current financial climate. For smaller subjects, like CAT, IT, Afrikaans, Technical Maths and Science, the training will be centralized in residential training sessions at Port Elizabeth NMPTDI. The intention is to train during selected weekdays in May 2022, as well as in August 2022, and to utilize the three holiday weeks available in June/July 2022.

Curriculum Management has been collaborating with Teacher Development to ensure that all teachers who attend Provincial courses have a high quality overall training experience. The GET and FET courses on offer have all been endorsed by SACE and teachers attending the full duration of these courses will therefore earn CPTD points. The intention remains to ensure that good quality training is provided, that will impact on teaching and learning practice, and still ensure that no classroom is left without a teacher during contact time.

It is therefore a pleasure to invite teachers to register for the Teacher Development Training courses on offer in this flyer by completing the google registration forms on-line, **on or before the closing date** of <u>Tuesday,14 June 2022.</u>

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What is the nature and focus of the courses? All courses published in the 2022/23 Prospectus will take the form of 2 weekdays and 5 days holiday courses addressing key teaching content and strategies specific to each subject listed. Weekday courses will be presented for 2 days from 8am-4pm (08h00-16h00).

Will trainees be assessed? Yes – trainees will be assessed in a pre- and post-test related directly to the content of the course to ascertain the impact of the training on their subject knowledge.

Who should attend? Subject Advisors / Subject Heads / Teachers responsible for the specific Grade/ Phase and Subject being targeted.

How many can attend? A group of 50 trainees per course listed in this flyer per District/ CMC.

Where is the training taking place? All training will take place at District/ CMC level. Where a course for a low enrolment subject, e.g. Technical subjects, is on offer, the course will be conducted at 1 centralized venue, i.e.PE NMPTDI, in the Province.

When are the courses taking place? The dates and times are indicated in this flyer.

Will accommodation be provided? There will be no provision of Accommodation and Transport at District/CMC LEVEL, ONLY Catering will be provided for. Accommodation will only be provided to trainees of smaller subjects who are hosted at central venues.

Will transport be provided? Districts are responsible for transporting teachers to and from residential trainings, in PE NMPTDI, at the start and the end of the five days. A shuttle will be available to transport teachers making use of accommodation between the training venue and place of accommodation for the 5 days. For trainings in Districts, trainees will take responsibility for their own transport.

How do I register? Use the unique link provided for each course to access the online registration form via the Internet or speak to your EDC Managers / District e-Learning Facilitators / Subject Advisors in the District to assist you. Register **on or before the closing date** of 14 June 2022 for the course you wish to attend. You will receive confirmation from Mthatha PTDI that you have been accepted to attend.
