GRADE 12 READINESS ASSESSMENT TOOL

1. The Eastern Cape Department of Education wishes to extend its sincere congratulations to the Grade 12 Class of 2021 for the good improvement achieved in the 2021 NSC Examination.
2. The Eastern Cape Province achieved a percentage pass rate of 73% which is a 4.9% improvement from 2020 and the second highest improvement nationally.
3. The province also achieved a remarkable achievement of 34.4% in the percentage of Bachelor Passes achieved which is a 3% increase from 2020.
4. There is more to be done as a province and it is the sincere wish of the department that we continue to improve the results both quantitatively and qualitatively.
5. The target pass for Grade 12 in the province has been set by the Head of Department at 77% for 2022. This is an increase of 4% from the pass rate achieved in 2021.
6. It is therefore expected that every school, subject, circuit, and district will work to achieve an increase of no less than 4% in their domain of responsibility.

7. Curriculum Instruction CD 01 of 2022 serves to start-off the interventions for Grade 12 through the circulation of a Grade 12 Readiness Tool that requires all schools with Grade 12 learners to assess themselves against the indicators in the Assessment Tool in view of supporting the Grade 12 learners in Term1.
8. Schools with Grade 12 learners must complete the information on the Grade 12 Readiness Tool as truthfully and accurately as possible and submit the information as per the deadline stipulated for the Circuit Mangers and District Directors to collate and forward to the Provincial Curriculum Office for assessment and planning for the rest of 2022.
