PROVINCIAL TEACHER DEVELOPMENT COURSES SCHEDULED FOR JUNE/ JULY 2019

1. In 2018 the Eastern Cape Department of Education (ECDOE) published a provincial Prospectus including all the provincial Teacher Development courses scheduled to take place in 2019 – see attached.
2. Each course focuses on the key curriculum content identified as an area of challenge during the analysis of subject results and is offered at a Provincial Teacher Development Institute over a 5-day period during the school holidays.
3. The courses on offer in the June/ July 2019 school holidays target key curriculum content and teaching methodology in the following subjects:


